<b>Ommegang Three Philosophers</b> - A curious but sublime blend of Ommegang (Dubbel) and Lindemans Kriek; warming alcohol, cherries and dried fruits. 9.8% abv.	\$ 6.95
<b>La Fin du Monde</b> - Belgian triple style ale, smooth, slightly tart with spicy aroma. From Quebec. 9% abv.	\$ 6.95
<b>Samuel Smith Old Brewery Pale Ale</b> - Classic Yorkshire bitter-malty, earthy and faintly buttery. 5% abv.	\$ 6.95
<b>Samuel Smith Nut Brown Ale</b> - Walnut-color and malty flavor, gently sweet. 5.4% abv.	\$ 6.95
<b>Samuel Smith Taddy Porter</b> - A dark and smooth classic from Yorkshire England. 5% abv.	\$ 6.95
